

RAPID INFORMATION SHEET – Secondary Schools

Rapid helps teachers identify dyslexia. We are currently updating this software and are recruiting teachers to help with the standardisation.

The fact that the software is used to help identify SEN is essentially irrelevant to the standardisation, as we need to recruit a representative sample, so we are looking for any teacher in a secondary mainstream school who is willing to test their whole class online.

The test administration will take around half an hour in total.

We will send you a spreadsheet in advance, for you to complete details of each participating pupil, which you can anonymise if you like.

Testing will take place at the end of January. As a thank you for your taking part, we will be offering **£250 free Testwise credits for one year group, £500 free Testwise credits for two or more year groups and £1000 free Testwise credits for the whole school participating.**

If desired, we will be able to supply reports that will include a probability of dyslexia for each student, but unfortunately not until a lot later in the year, since the report development work will not have started at time of testing.

If you would like to take part, we hope that you can recruit other teachers in your school, who will also be eligible for the incentive.

There is a small chance that we may not be able to include everyone, as we need to make sure that the sample is representative of the UK population.
